NOTICE ABOUT COMPULSORY EARTHQUAKE INSURANCE POLICY

Dear Insured,

Compulsory Earthquake Insurance has become a legal obligation by the Disaster Insurance Law numbered 6305 published in the official newspaper on May 09, 2012.

What kind of buildings are subject to Compulsory Earthquake Insurance?

- Independent sections indicated under Condominium Law 634
- Buildings constructed as "residence" on real property that are subject to private ownership and is registered to deed office and independent sections within these buildings that are used for commercial purposes.
- Residences built by or with the credit of government due to a natural catastrophe

If your property insured by our company falls within above requirements, we hereby like to draw your attention to your obligation of having Compulsory Earthquake Insurance

What are the covers that are NOT granted by this policy?

Compulsory Earthquake Insurance covers your building up to the per square meter construction value and maximum insurance value determined by Turkish Treasury. We are more than ready to insure the portion that exceeds Compulsory Earthquake Insurance value and contents like furnitures, inventories and stocks for earthquake risk.

How can you have your Compulsory Earthquake Insurance policy?

You may kindly apply to our agencies, İŞ Bank branches or directly to Anadolu Insurance to have your Compulsory Earthquake Insurance policy or to cover your ownings for the risks that are not protected by this policy.

Due to corresponding legislations, it is not possible to grant Optional Earthquake Cover for buildings that do not have Compulsory Earthquake Insurance. We hereby would like to emphasize that, we can not grant Optional Earthquake Cover and had to omit Optional Earthquake Covers granted before, if you have not send the information of your Compulsory Earthquake Insurance policy to our company. Please kindly call your agency or our company to regain Optional Earthquake Cover.
